You **MUST** be **REGISTERED** to vote in this election.

1. Mark your ballot carefully by placing an "x" in the space(s) provided to indicate the candidate of your choice.
2. After marking your ballot, seal it in a plain envelope. **DO NOT** place your name or other identifying information on this envelope or on the ballot itself.
3. Place the envelope containing the completed ballot inside another envelope which should then be addressed and mailed to:

4. Your return address on this outer envelope **MUST** include your full name, street address and **SIGNATURE** as shown on the LA County Registration list. An envelope without a complete address and signature will void your ballot!

Your return address and signature on the outer envelope will be used to verify your eligibility **BEFORE IT IS OPENED**. Ballots and envelopes will then be separated prior to tabulation to assure the secrecy of your vote. **NOTE:** If you recently registered or re-registered, your name may not be on the registry list. In this case, attach a photocopy of your registration card and place it in the outside envelope so your eligibility can be confirmed.

**MAIL YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT EARLY!**

Ballots must be received by 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday November 2nd 2004.

Absentee ballots will be accepted at the Polling Place.
